On behalf of the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities, I am pleased to inform you that at its June 25-26, 2014, meeting, the Board of Commissioners accepted North Idaho College's Spring 2014 Year One *Mission and Core Themes* Report which was to include an addendum to address Recommendation 2 of the Spring 2013 Year Seven *Mission Fulfillment and Sustainability* Peer Evaluation. The Commission determined that its expectations have been met in regard to the aforementioned Recommendation.

In addition, the Board of Commissioners accepted North Idaho College's Ad Hoc Report which was to address Recommendations 4 and 5 of the Spring 2013 Year Seven *Mission Fulfillment and Sustainability* Peer Evaluation. In accepting the Ad Hoc Report the Commission determined that with respect to Recommendation 5 of the Spring 2013 Year Seven *Mission Fulfillment and Sustainability* Peer Evaluation the College is now in compliance with Standards 2.A.14 and 2.A.16.

The institution's next regularly scheduled evaluation is the Mid-Cycle Evaluation in spring 2016. This evaluation replaces the Year Three *Resources and Capacity* Evaluation. The Mid-Cycle Evaluation is intended to ascertain the institution's readiness to provide evidence (outcomes) of mission fulfillment and sustainability in the Year Seven *Mission Fulfillment and Sustainability* Evaluation. It is aimed at assisting institutions in determining if the process of outcomes assessment will lead the institution to a successful Year Seven *Mission Fulfillment and Sustainability* Self Evaluation and Peer Evaluation.
