



ASNIC Resolution
REGARDING The North Idaho College Board of Trustees

WHEREAS, The Associated Students of North Idaho College Student Government has passed a vote of no confidence in the Board of Trustees. As elected officials, it is your responsibility to maintain the values, standards, and integrity of established and procurement policy of the institution while working to support the best interest of all your constituents, including the student body. We have not been represented by the Board of Trustees, and the actions of the Board of Trustees have not been in the interests of the students. The recent actions by the Board of Trustees, including but not limited to, placing President Nick Swayne on immediate administrative leave have caused large amounts of concern.

THEREFORE, In response to the lack of clarity in recent Board decisions, the Board must immediately move to complete transparency, and practice professional, ethical, and legal conduct. This involves making all items available on the agenda before meetings, speaking clearly, not whispering as to obstruct one's voice, and following all NIC policies and state procurement laws. The Board will reinstate Dr. Nick Swayne as President of North Idaho College, effective immediately, in order to exercise complete transparency and start representing the best interests of students and North Idaho College.
